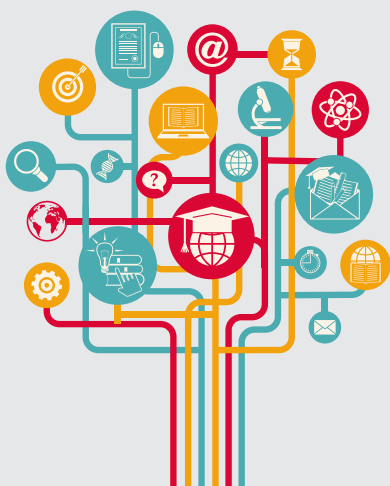


MESSAGE FROM CHAIRMAN DIPLOMA BOARD, ISTD
